Adult Running Group

Next week West Branch Parks and Recreation will start a Running Club. Participants will meet twice a week for a short program and a group run. Participants will be given a log to record their progress. Becky Hosier and Jodi Yeggy have taken the lead on the program. Jodi will be the team lead for the advanced runners, Becky Hosier will lead the intermediate runners, and Park & Rec Director Melissa Russell will lead the beginning runners. Girls on the Run Program

Our application for the Girls on the Run program has been approved! Melissa has several volunteer coaches lined up and she will serve as the head coach. Coaches training will be held on August 26th. She has various activities planned including scooter races, parachute games, and tumbling activities. Melissa anticipates numbers to level off and slowly decline over the next few weeks. Camp Registrations

Summer Day camp has already hit the maximum number of 30 participants. Park and Rec Director Melissa Russell will be seeking additional adult assistance and is confident this will allow more participants to attend. This will be a fun-filled week including trips to Dubuque, Muscatine, Tipton, Cedar Valley Park, Iowa City. Teen Week activities currently have very low registrations. Teen week activities may need to be cancelled if participation numbers do not increase. We will have a better idea of Teen Week participation numbers by the end of June.

- **Library Update**: The Board of Trustees of the West Branch Public Library met for their regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 18th. The trustees met with the library's building consultant, George Lawson, in regards to the library building program project. At the meeting, the board discussed and approved the final revision of the building program, completing the project that began with the public input forums at the beginning of April. The completed forty-five page document from this project compiles input from members of the community who attended the forums, library staff, and library trustees into a document that provides guidelines for architects to complete pre-funding design work and site selection. Details of the report will be presented to community and city council at a council meeting during July. At the June 18th board meeting, approval was also given for the architect and site selection processes. The library will be again looking to Lawson for consulting during these processes.
