Date: August 26, 2013 Weekly Council Update

- 6th & Main Street Project Update: Aero Saw was in town on Friday to cut the area around the manhole at 6th & Main. Public Works staff will work to reset the manhole tomorrow, Tuesday, August 28th. Main Street will be down to one lane while work is being completed, but both lanes are expected to be open by mid-afternoon.
- **REAP Grant:** The Resource Enhancement and Protection (REAP) Grant, a grant program offered by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, will hold their selection day on September 17th on the second floor of the Wallace Building in Des Moines at 9:30 a.m. There are twenty-five cities with populations ranging from 2,093 to 17,278 competing for \$912,203 in funding. The total amount of grants requested by the twenty-five communities is \$2,129,878.
- Park & Recreation Update: The Park and Rec Department is gearing up for fall programs. Registration forms are now available for Flag Football, Volleyball, and the next round of Tough Mother Fitness Classes. Zumba will be starting on Tuesday evenings in late September. Park and Rec will be adding a Toddler time starting October 2nd. This is a program that was done in the past and we are bringing it back by request.

Park and Rec participation numbers have been compiled for 2013. Below, a chart is provided that shows the various programs and participation numbers from 2009-2013. Overall participation continues to increase. There was a slight decline in the number of participants in youth sports, however, fluctuation is normal from year to year. Next year this number will have a large increase due to the fact that West Branch Summer League will become a Park and Recreation program.

The Park and Recreation Commission met on Wednesday, August 21st for their regular meeting. They agreed that the regular meeting time will now be the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00pm in the West Branch City Council Chambers. The Commission will develop a rating system for the incoming RFQ's and will recommend 5 different firms to the West Branch City Council. The Commission also discussed forming committees, but decided to wait until the Commission is expanded before forming them. Some of the possible committees mentioned were the Building and Grounds Committee, Fundraising Committee, Trails Committee and an Activities Committee.
