PUBLIC, DEPARTMENT HEADS, COMMISSIONS, CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND CITY COUNCIL

Resolution 1114, cancelling the Amended Tax Increment Development Agreement dated January 2, 2008 between the City of West Branch and Acciona Energy North America./Move to action.

Kevin Olson briefed the Council on the letter received from Acciona addressing the breach to the amended tax increment development agreement. Olson stated that there has been a lack of communication from Acciona and that the company confirmed that they did not meet their obligations under the agreement. Under these circumstances, Olson recommended cancellation of the agreement. ICAD representative Mark Nolte stated that he was speaking on behalf of ICAD's role representing both West Branch and Acciona. Nolte stated that he was not aware of the lack of communication from Acciona to the City. Nolte detailed some of the market conditions that have challenged the wind industry and confirmed that Acciona has not met the requirements in the TIF agreement. Nolte stated that he would reach out to Acciona and encourage a representative of the company to contact the City.

“National Geodetic Vertical Datum” with “North American Vertical Datum.” North American Vertical Datum is a set of data used by surveyors to determine the elevation of a property. WHEREAS, a non-profit entity, West Branch Dog Park, Inc., has been formed for the promotion of the development of the dog park; and

WHEREAS, West Branch Dog Park, Inc., would like to construct fencing, a shelter and benches and seed the property for use as a dog park; and

WHEREAS, West Branch Dog Park, Inc., has agreed to obtain any permits or permissions necessary for development of the park; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the City Council to approve the development of the property as a dog park.
