



## Residential Curb Side Yard Waste Collection

Public Works staff provides curbside yard waste collection each Monday beginning in April through mid-November.

Collection takes place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. every Monday. (Holidays will delay the service by one day.) Yard waste not placed on the curb by 7:00 a.m. will not be collected until the following week.

Residents utilizing this service are asked to place yard waste in biodegradable paper bags or a reusable container which can be dumped and returned curbside, bags will not be returned. Yard waste includes waste produced during gardening, grass clippings, leaves, flowers, branches and tree limbs. All tree limbs must be cut to four-foot lengths, bundled and tied.

The City will not accept:

- yard waste in plastic bags
- yard waste not in a container (no tarps)
- yard waste containing debris (plastic, cans, bottles, etc.)
- pet waste
- Containers weighing over 50 lbs

The City has a brush/yard waste pile that is located on Fawcett Drive that residents may access at their convenience. The site is locked, however keys to the brush pile can be checked out at the City Office during normal business hours.
