

West Branch City Council City Administrator's Report 7/9/18

Pending Action Items:

(No New News - Report below is previous report)

We reconvene the Wastewater Task Group June 21st and weighed options in reviewing potential pilot projects of the technologies we have visited. V&K our engineering consultants has informed the Task Group that our current lagoon system is operating at, or over capacity. Although, it's early for cost projections; being over capacity right now means that any Alternative Wastewater process if chosen would require an additional \$1 million to add an additional lagoon. It is likely this will take a big bite out of the project cost savings an alternative wastewater treatment process would have over an Aero-mod Wastewater Treatment Plant However, We still believe that the cost of operating a plant would still be considerable higher than a lagoon process. Task-group will test these theories by having V&K to start the work of conducting analysis that compares mechanical versus the non-mechanical opinions the Wastewater Task Group has toured. We expect to have this started analysis for our next Wastewater Task Group Meeting. We also expect to have the DNR required facility study scope of work / process identified and presented to the City Council in the coming month.

College Street Bridge

V&K completed a general inspection of the College Street Bridge. Due to the condition of the bridge it requires an annual inspection. As you know, the bridge continues to be in poor condition and V&K has identify several holes that will need filled before the openings lead to much larger hole(s). Public Works is scheduled to fill them this week.
