Water & Sewer Service

is provided by the City of West Branch. Services can be established by calling 319-643-5888. Water and sewer problems after hours, on weekends or holidays, should be reported to 319-325-8213.

Water meters are read on the 20th of each month. Bills are mailed the 1st of the month with payment due on the 20th.

A \$100 deposit is required for all rental properties where the tenant establishes service. Upon disconnection of service, the deposit—less deductions for any unpaid water usage, penalties and interest—shall be returned.

Landscape meters may be used for outside watering. Call the City Office for more information.

Water/Sewer Payments may be:

- ACH payments—Easy Pay forms are available on our website
- Mailed to City of West Branch, PO Box 218, West Branch, Iowa 52358
- Placed in a secure drop box at the north end of the City Office building
- Paid in person at the City Office, 110 N Poplar Street
- Pay by phone—debit or credit

Garbage Collection and Recycling is provided by Johnson County Refuse Inc. All recycle and garbage containers should be placed curbside on **Fridays by 7 a.m.**

Garbage that cannot be recycled must be placed in garbage bags or cans with the required yellow sticker attached. **No cans larger than 35 gallon are allowed.** **Stickers cost \$1.25 each and may be purchased at the City Office, Jack & Jill or Casey's.** Year-round garbage stickers may be purchased from Johnson County Refuse. To make arrangements for special pick-ups such as old appliances or other items too large for the garbage, call 877-423-9877.

Curbside Recycling is mandatory. A monthly fee of \$4.75 is included in your monthly water and sewer bill (whether or not you recycle). Each residence is provided free recycling bins. Bins are available at the City Office.

The following items can be recycled and no longer need to be sorted:

- Plastic: Plastic with recycle emblem #1-7. Containers must be washed clean.
- Metal: Tin and aluminum cans. Must be washed clean & labels removed.
- Glass: Clear, brown, blue and green. Must be washed clean.
- Paper (newspaper, magazines, old phone books, etc.)
- Cardboard: Corrugated or chip-board. Must be flattened and no larger than 2'x2' pieces.

The following items are NOT recyclable:

- Styrofoam
- Plastic Bags
- Broken Glass
- Window or mirror glass
- Cardboard not broken down
- Tissue Paper and Paper Plates.

Yard Waste The City picks up yard waste every Monday (from April thru November) curb side. Please visit our website for details. **Bio-degradable bags are available at the City Office for purchase.** Yard waste may also be taken to the City brush pile on Fawcett Drive. Keys are available at the City Office.

Leaf Pick Up is provided each fall. Please rake your leaves to the curb for the City to vacuum or leaves may be bagged and left at the curb for pick up during yard waste collection on Monday's. Bio-degradable bags only - no plastic.



Christmas Trees (free of plastic, ornamentation and stands) may be placed at the curb to be picked up by the City in January.

Burning is only allowed as a recreational activity with an approved burn permit. Permits are available on our website or at the City Office. It is illegal to burn garbage or yard waste.



Pet Registration is required for dogs and cats over four months of age within the city limits. Tags cost \$5 per pet (\$20 if not spayed or neutered) and must be renewed by January 31 of each year.

The Town Hall Community building is located at 201 E. Main Street and has a community room available to rent. There is a \$65 user fee for events without alcoholic beverages. Events serving alcohol require a \$100 user fee plus a \$100 deposit. Non-profit organizations may use the facility for free. To make reservations, visit our website to reserve online or call the City Office at 319-643-5888.

Beranek Park has a shelter that may be reserved free of charge. To reserve, visit our website or call the City Office at 319-643-5888.

Building Permits are needed before any type of construction or improvements can begin. Permit fees are calculated according to the cost of the project. Forms are available at the City Office or on our website.
