






**Pending Action Items:**

*(Wastewater Task Group)*

The Taskforce met with Gross-Wen to have additional questions answered and the committee plan to have in-state site visits at two other wastewater treatment system July 15<sup>th</sup>. Our goal is to present to the City Council our recommended option(s) at our July 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting. The Baldrige Environmental Pilot Project is continuing to move forward. We are still investigating DNR's willingness to extend certain compliance deadlines in order to properly gauge the success of the Baldrige Treatment Process. Thus, far early indicators are positive. We hope this project will reduce our lagoon sludge and allow our lagoon wastewater process to perform with higher efficiency. Allowing the ammonia level to much more manageable and potential at levels well within state compliance levels.

*(College Street Bridge)*



Last week, the contractor finished placing the bridge deck support beams and setting rebar in preparation to pour the bridge. The subdrain was installed and the roadway was rocked with modified subbase to maintained access until pavement is placed. The bridge deck was poured.
