



Fall Leaf Pickup

The City provides curbside leaf collection during October and November. Leaf collection begins at approximately 7:30 am on the EAST side of town and works WEST on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. While Public Works makes every attempt to reach the whole town each day, occasionally leaf collection cannot be completed in one day.

Residents who live on streets with curb and gutter are asked to rake leaves in the gutter line. If you live on a street without a gutter, please place your leaves as close to the street as possible so crews can reach them.

Leaf piles should be free of tree limbs, sticks, grass clippings, garbage and any foreign objects. Leaves mixed with other yard waste or placed in plastic bags will not be accepted.

Residents who are able to utilize off-street parking on collection days are encouraged to do so.

Public Works will continue collections through November or until the first snowfall. After that time residents can haul leaves and yard waste to the City brush pile located on Fawcett Drive. Keys to the collection site may be checked out at the City Office during normal business hours.
