



Residential Curb Side Yard Waste Collection

Public Works staff provides curbside yard waste collection each Monday beginning the 1st Monday in April through mid-November.

Collection takes place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. each Monday. (Holidays will delay the service by one day.) Yard waste not placed on the curb by 8:00 a.m. will not be collected until the following week.

Residents utilizing this service **must place yard waste in biodegradable paper bags only (30 gallon max)**. Bags are available for purchase at the City Office or they can also be purchased at Menards, Lowes or other local retailers.

Yard waste includes: waste produced during gardening, grass clippings, leaves, flowers, branches and tree limbs. All branches and tree limbs must be cut to no longer than four-foot in length, bundled and tied.

The City will not accept:

- yard waste in plastic bags or containers of any kind (wheel barrows, garbage cans, etc.)
- yard waste containing debris (plastic, cans, bottles, trash etc.)
- pet waste

The City has a compost/brush/yard waste pile located on Fawcett Drive (south of I-80, and east of Acciona/Nordex) that residents may access at their convenience. The site is locked, however keys to the brush pile can be checked out at the City Office during normal business hours. For small loads, an unlocked walk through gate is available.
