

West Branch City Council City Administrator's Report 3/01/21

Pending Action Items:

(Wastewater Treatment)

Administration is working on setting up a meeting with West Branch Villages regarding participation / connecting with the City of West Branch wastewater treatment system. City Staff have had a meeting with V&K and talked about the possibility of seeking Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding with the assistance of ECIA. Once we know the parameters to a potential CDBG grant we will move forward with the admiration of West Branch Village.

(Cedar / Johnson Roundabout)

This project has been added to the Capital Improvement Plan. Currently, V&K is working with the County Engineer over the parts of the project which should be on the city's portion of participation, and what should be on Johnson County's portion of the project. I suspect that one all of the parts of the project is considered amicable then we will move forward with a 28e Agreement draft(s).

(Wapsi Creek Widening)

V&K has concluded it work on clarifying the scope of the project, and planned to reconvene conversations with the Gaskill family to gain construction easement rights. There remain gaps in funding for this project, but there are a couple of grant prospects that remain hopeful; however, we believe we have sufficient funds for design and part of construction without external lending. If this project takes off and moves faster than we anticipated our budget does account for taking out conventional lending the cover the gap.

Parkside Development)

Although this project in still in the preliminary plat stage. There has been some challenges in addressing stormwater issues. Staff have met and conferred with developers and presented some options that could be deployed with development. As we work through these issues the topic of Tax Increment Financing has come up as it relates to elevating infrastructure cost. Although there has been no specifics or any type of formal request this may be a topic that may need City Council's attention at some point.

Report from the Desk of the City Administrator:

The Cedar County Roads Department would like the public to be aware of bridge construction. The
County Awarded a Contract to Jim Schroeder Construction to replace the bridge on 290th between
374 and 429 street address. Approval to start was February 16, 2021. The road will be closed for
approximately 4 months during construction. A detour is established on Interstate 80. For further
