#### **Spring and Summer Program Update**

Registrations are open for summer ball programs. 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade boys' teams are full. Kindergarten teams still need coaches. The numbers are small for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Girls' 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> girls' teams are small, and 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> is also small. Sand volleyball will be led by Abbey Christoffel and we will offer support when needed. Swimming lessons are open, and camps will occur in July.

#### **Easter Updates**

Easter Egg Hunt is March 27 and makeup date is April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Looking for more help. WBPL and high school volunteers are helping. There are 55 families registered for the Easter Egg Hunt and 26 for Easter Basket delivery.

#### Park Updates

Standard operating manual completed and sent to the state health department. The concession inspection will be in April. They will start work on the parking lot at Cubby in about 2 weeks. It is still too wet right now.

Additional signage for Cubby has been ordered. Signs will say "No hitting against the fence, no dogs on the field, no hitting golf balls on the field, do not use if the filed is reserved or prepared for a game, not liable for accidents or injuries". It was suggested to add "no sunflower seeds".

Camp Swim Trips
Summer Camps will

swim once a week in the afternoons weather permitting in Tipton or West Liberty. All campers are required to go and dress for swim time. Children not swimming should be prepared to be outside in warm weather and dress accordingly.

# **2021 Fees per session:** Fees are per participant.

**Basic Camp Early/Late Option** \$125 \$25

- There are no scholarships available for camps.
- \$25 cancellation fee will be assessed for all weekly session withdrawals.
- \$75 cancellation fee will be assessed if cancellation is made within one week of session start date.
- Camp registrations are confirmed on a first registered AND paid/first served basis.
- \* Registration is limited to 4-12 campers per session.
- Camp registration closes 2 weeks before the next session OR when the session is filled.

# Red Cross Swim Lesson Bus Monday-Friday June7-June 18

- Bus will begin loading at the West Branch Public Library at 8:15 am and return around 10:30 am
- The bus fee is \$20 per person or \$30 family rate payable to the City of West Branch.
- Children should wear a coverup or towel over swimsuits to limit time in the locker room to change before or after class.
- You must also register for swim lessons with Tip-ton Aquatic Center. There is a \$40 fee for swim lessons.
- ❖ Masks and social distancing will be enforced when appropriate.
- Registration deadline May 21<sup>st</sup>.

#### Rec on the Go

Do you find it difficult to get out of the house for Park and Recreation activities, but would still like your kids to participate? We will bring programs to YOU! This is great for daycares, neighborhoods, families that want to have extra programs, but do not want the hassle of getting their group to a location.

#### Here is how it works:

- ❖ Register for a day and time(Tuesday mornings from 9am-11 and or Wednesdays from 1-3). We will let you know your specific time after registrations are complete.
- We will bring a different program to you each week and of course stay and staff the program.
- All programs must be outside.
   Programs will last about 30-45 minutes.
- Provider or adult must stay present at your house(sorry, you can't run that quick errand)....but you can use this time to take a quick breathe while we entertain the children!

Parents of children with disabilities, language barriers, or children requiring special arrangements such as medication or behavior incentive plans, should contact the Parks and Recreation Director at the time of registration or at least 2 weeks prior to attending camp. The Recreation Program Supervisor and parent(s)/guardian(s) will determine a plan to accommodate the child in a safe and positive format. Campers are divided in groups of approximately ten with one counselor assigned per group. Campers are expected to function in 10 campers to 1 staff ratio.

# health and safety.

Keeping our participants and staff safe during the pandemic is our top priority at West Branch Parks and Recreation. We will continue to monitor and seek guidance for program operation from the Cedar County Health Department and the City of West Branch. Health and safety guidelines will include, but will not be limited to:

- Participants and staff will be expected to a wear a mask when we are at enclosed buildings and social distancing can't be achieved and during transportation.
- Social distancing will be encouraged throughout the day.
- Participants will be divided into smaller groups by age. Camp numbers will be limited to around 12 campers a session.
- Participants and staff will wash hands and/or hand sanitize frequently throughout the day. Including: at the start of the day, prior to snack or lunch, before and after each group activity, after using the restroom and after touching one's face.
- Staff will sanitize high touch surfaces throughout the day. Individual supplies will be made available in lieu of sharing materials whenever feasible.
