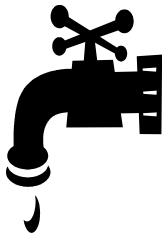

Water & Sewer Service

is provided by the City of West Branch. Services can be established by calling 319-643-5888. Water and sewer problems should be reported to the Public Works Director. 319-325-8213

Water meters are read each month. Bills are mailed the 1st of the month with payment due on the 20th.

A \$100 deposit is required for all rental properties where the tenant establishes service. Upon disconnection of service, the deposit—less deductions for any unpaid water usage, penalties and interest—shall be returned.

Landscape meters may be used for outside seasonal watering. Call the City Office for more information.

Trash and Recycling is provided by Johnson County Refuse Inc. All trash and recycling carts should be placed curbside on **Friday's by 7 a.m.**

Trash (picked up weekly)

35 gallon cart \$12.75—per month
65 gallon cart \$14.75—per month

Stickers for extra trash that does not fit in the cart cost \$3.00 each and can be purchased at the City Office or Casey's. To make arrangements for special pick-ups such as old appliances or other items too large for the garbage, call Johnson County Refuse 319-665-4498.

Recycling (picked up weekly)

65 gallon cart—\$4.75 per month
95 gallon cart—\$4.75 per month

Curbside Yard Waste Collection: (April-November)

Public Works picks up yard waste every Monday morning. Please have your bags out by 7:00 a.m. Yard waste must be placed in **bio-degradable bags**. **Bags are available at the City Office for purchase.** Yard waste may also be taken to the City brush pile on Fawcett Drive.

Leaf Pick Up: (Oct. & Nov.)

Public Works will vacuum leaves on Monday, Wednesday and Friday during October and November. Please rake your leaves to the curb for collection. Bagged leaves will not be collected. Yard waste, sticks or trash cannot be mixed with leaves.



Christmas Trees (free of plastic, ornamentation and stands) may be placed at the curb to be picked up by the City in January.

Burning is only allowed as a recreational activity with an approved burn permit. Permits are available on our website. It is illegal to burn garbage or yard waste at any time.

Pet Registration is required for dogs and cats over four months of age within the city limits. Tags cost \$5 per pet (\$20 if not spayed or neutered). Pet registration is required annually or can be issued for multiple years (coinciding with the rabies expiration date.)
