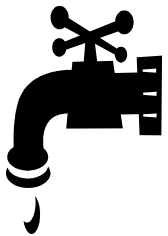

Water & Sewer Service

is provided by the City of West Branch. New service can be established by calling 319-643-5888, option 1. After hours water or sewer issues should be reported to the Public Works Director. 319-325-8213

Monthly Billing

Water meters are read on or around the 20th of each month. Bills are sent out on the 1st and due on the 20th.

You can choose a paper bill or e-bill at any time.

Water/Sewer/Trash & Recycling payments:

- Pay online— www.westbranchiowa.org
- Via ACH —Easy Pay forms are available on our website or at the City Office
- Mail checks to City of West Branch, PO Box 218, West Branch, Iowa 52358
- Place your payment in our secure drop box located at the City Office
- Pay in person at the City Office

Utility Deposit:

A \$150 deposit is required for all rental properties where the tenant establishes service.

Trash and Recycling is provided by Johnson County Refuse aka LRS. All trash and recycling carts should be placed curbside on **Friday morning (no later than 6 a.m.) or on Thursday evening.**

Trash (picked up weekly)

35 gallon cart \$12.75—per month

65 gallon cart \$14.75—per month

Stickers for extra trash that does not fit in the cart cost \$3.00 each and can be purchased at the City Office or Casey's. To make arrangements for special pick-ups such as old appliances or other items too large for the garbage, call Johnson County Refuse 319-665-4498.

Recycling (picked up weekly)

65 gallon cart—\$4.75 per month

95 gallon cart—\$4.75 per month

Curbside Yard Waste Collection: (April-November) - (free service)

Public Works picks up yard waste every Monday morning. Please have your bags out by 6:00 a.m. Yard waste must be placed in **bio-degradable bags**. **Bags are available at the City Office for purchase or you may purchase bags from other sources.**

Leaf Pick Up: (Late Oct. & Nov.) - (free service)

Public Works vacuums leaves on certain days during October and November. Leaves must be raked to the curb for collection. Bagged leaves will not be collected. Yard waste, sticks or trash cannot be mixed with leaves.



Christmas Trees (free of plastic, ornamentation and stands) may be placed at the curb to be picked up by the City in January.

Burning is allowed as a recreational activity ONLY. It is illegal to burn garbage or yard waste at all times.

Pet Registration is required for dogs and cats over four months of age.

Registration fees are:

\$10 per dog

\$5 per cat

\$25 if not spayed or neutered

Building Permits are required before any type of construction or improvements can begin. Permit fees are calculated according to the cost of the project. Permits are available on our website.
