Attention West Branch Residents

The City of West Branch adopted the 2015 International Residential Code and the 2020 Electrical Code. Building permits are required for anyone who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure. This is also in effect for anyone who wishes to erect, install, enlarge, alter repair, move, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system. This shall include, but limited to:

Decks

Porches or porch supports Screen Porches/Covered porches

Room additions Interior remodels

Pergola Storage Sheds

Garages (attached or detached) Single Family Dwellings

Duplexes Zero Lot Lines

Multi-family Dwellings

Commercial remodels and additions

Commercial Building Commercial Roofing Commercial Siding Pole Buildings

Fences

Swimming Pools

Signs

Basement Remodel Egress Windows

S.F.D roof where 50% of sheathing is removed

Retaining walls over 4ft high

- Building permits shall be applied for prior to commencement of work.
- Building permits shall include an accurate set of building plans drawn to scale (1/4 /ft.)
- Building permits shall be picked up, paid for and approved **prior** to starting project.
- Anyone performing work without an approved permit shall be subject to an additional fee equal to half the original permit fee.
- Any person working without a permit shall be issued a stop work order which must be brought to city hall when applying for a permit
- Each building permit has required inspections which must be performed prior to any cover up, if inspector is not called for inspections and cover up is complete, the owner and/or contractor will be required to uncover work for inspection.
- All inspections must pass inspection before work can continue to next phase.
- Every single-family dwelling, duplex, multi-family and commercial/industrial building must pass a final inspection prior to occupancy of the building.
- Any building occupied prior to passing final inspection the owner and/or contractor may be fined as per stated in the City of West Branch City Code.
- Projects which do not require a Certificate of Occupancy shall have a final inspection prior to use of structure. Failure to call for an inspection and/or failure to pass the final inspection prior to use may result in a civil penalty per the City of West Branch City Code.
- After passing a final inspection of S.F.D, Duplexes, multi-family dwellings, commercial/industrial a Certificate of Occupancy shall be issued to the owner and structure will be allowed to be occupied.
