
WHEREAS, Advantage has submitted a proposed Site Plan for the Property; and

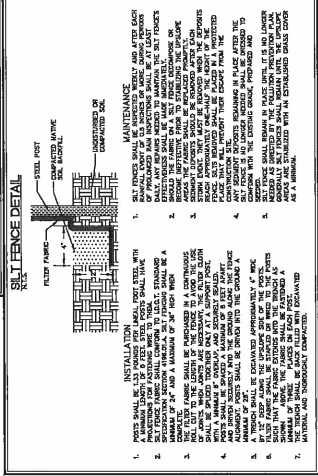

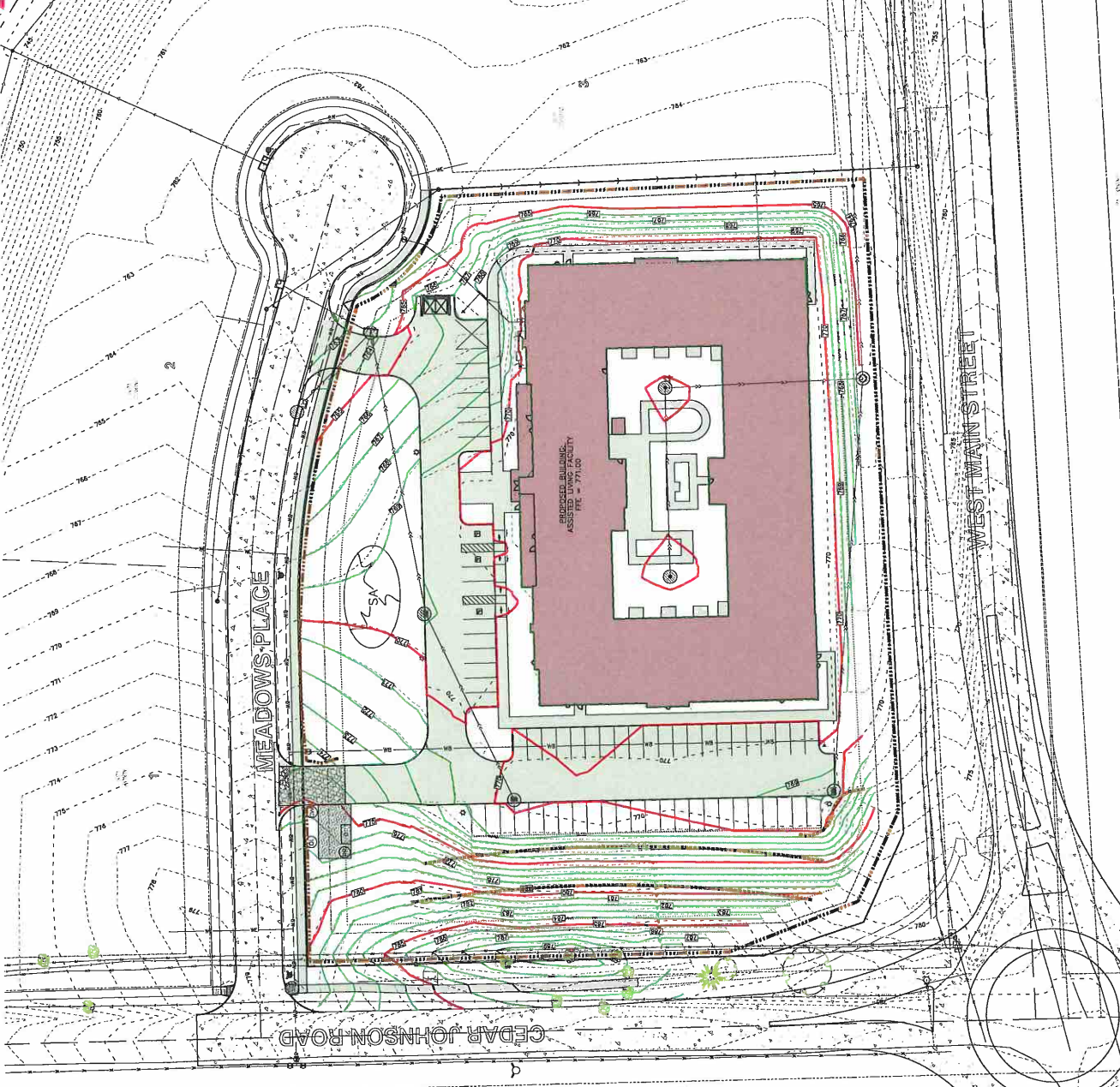

- MAXIMUM SLOPE ON CUTS AND FILLS SHALL BE 3:1 HORIZONTAL TO 1:1 VERTICAL.
 - NO EXCAVATION SHALL BE ALLOWED WITHIN 2' OF PROPERTY LINES.
 - ALL EXCAVATION SHALL BE PROTECTED BY EROSION CONTROL MEASURES.
 - CONSTRUCTION TO BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE IOWA EROSION CONTROL ACT.
 - ALL NECESSARY EROSION CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE INSTALLED BEFORE ANY EXCAVATION OR GRADING BEGINS.

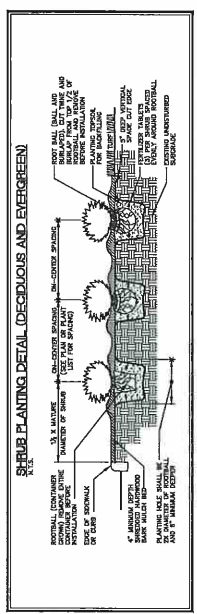
