RENTAL PROPERTY LIEN EXEMPTION

The Rental Property Lien Exemption program is designed to assist rental property owners from having liens placed against their property due to failure by the tenant to pay utility bills they may be responsible for under their rental/lease agreement.

Landlords have a 30-calendar day window after the city is notified the tenant has started water service with the City of West Branch to provide written notice to the City under State of Iowa Code 384.84(4)(e). Participation in the program protects property owners from having unpaid charges for sewer, clean water and /of garbage utility fees assessed against their rental property while a tenant occupies the property. The program does not apply to charges for repairs related to service of sewer systems, stormwater drainage systems, sewer treatment and solid waste disposal if repair charges become delinquent.
