a) Interim Development Ordinance update:

Using a copy of the current ordinance, tweaking is currently being done to be able to present a new ordinance to the public. The new language will preserve the small town feel of West Branch. It needs to be refined and made better by preserving and protecting the businesses of West Branch. It will negatively impact someone and we need to be ready for this. The ordinance has the full support of the city council and Main Street-West Branch. The goal is 8 weeks before it can be presented to the public.

b) Certified Local Government update:

Adam is still tweaking the application, to be ready January 2025.

c) Traveler's Rest Nomination update:

The National Park Service needs to write up a national historic nomination. Dana will contact NPS and check on the progress.

d) Traveler's Rest Renovation update:

Update through ECIA interior renovations need to be done, the historic nomination needs to get done. Additional funds need to be found. The renovation needs to be appropriate for economic development with changes to priorities and significance.

SAMPLE IDEAS:

- **Storytelling Nights**: Invite long-time residents to share personal stories and oral histories.
- Mural or Public Art: Commission a mural or sculpture depicting West Branch's founding and growth.
- **175th Anniversary Publication**: Publish a commemorative book or booklet documenting West Branch's history.
- **Speaker Series**: Host lectures or panels on local history, preservation, and the city's future.
- **Historic Home Open House**: Partner with homeowners to allow public visits to historic homes.
- **175th Anniversary Logo**: Create a logo for use on banners, merchandise, and promotional materials.
- **Social Media Campaign**: Share "175 days of history" leading up to the event, featuring daily posts on key moments.
